Overview of the event:

The main aim of the seminar was to generate awareness among the girl students of AIMT and other colleges of Guwahati to handle issues like eve teasing and voyeurism.

The program started with introductory speech by Ms Sayanika Deka Sarma, member of the women's cell. This was followed by a short speech by the Director of AIMT who encouraged the students to talk and fight against any kind of sexual harassment. The principal of AIMT was the next speaker who asked the gathering specially female students, to discuss free and frankly about their own safety and the problems they face against eve teasing, peeping toms, molestation, rape, acid attack, voyeurism etc. with mentors, parents or anybody they can trust. He also advised girls in Guwahati or Assam to carry gas sprays/ pepper sprays for their own safety.

Abstract of the Topic Presented:

The main programme of the day was conducted by Ms Pallavi Guha Baruah, HOD computer Science Department. In this session, the students were advised on the legal aspects of handling a case of abuse. She shared helpline numbers and initiatives started by the Government of Assam in handling harassment crimes. Overall the programme was very informative for students as they could understand the legal recourse they could appeal for in such harassment cases.

The workshop was very informative and it was highly interactive. All the students and the faculty members were appreciative of the college's initiative in creating the women's cell in the institute.
